

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

A game master or dungeon master can never have too many random tables. Random tables fill the gaps and supply details that are too tedious to create beforehand.

The tables in this book operate exactly like the tables in other books in the Books of Random Tables series. GMs and DMs can roll percentile dice on the tables or they can have their players roll at appropriate times.

Never tell a player they find nothing in a room and never miss an opportunity to add layers of complexity to your campaign. Random tables are a dungeon master's best friend.

The first section of tables in this book is Items & Things. These are D100 tables of common and unique items that are arranged either by location or item type. Included are Book Titles, Items in a Cargo Hold, Items in a Wizard's Lab, and more.

The next section is Places & Locations. Adventurers need places to adventure. These two tables provide worlds of opportunity for fun adventures. Tourist Traps is an entertaining addition to fantasy space settings and, of course, Worlds and Places are a must.


Discovering new lifeforms is one of the main appeals of space settings. The Alien Animals section gives game masters interesting creatures for their players' characters to encounter.

Getting existing fantasy characters into space can be challenging. The Ways to Space section makes sure characters can be taken into space in creative and memorable ways.

The Rumors section gives dungeon masters the ability to add side quests or simply add dynamism to games by creating the feeling that other things are happening outside the characters' immediate surroundings.

Game masters always need names and lots of them. The Names section ensures that GMs and DMs will never get caught without a setting-appropriate name. There are Insectoid Names, Mechanical Being Names, Ooze Names, Ship Names, Space Clown Names, and World Names.

I have created these tables to help game masters run the best game possible. It is my hope that they will contribute to a vast array of adventures in astral and celestial seas.

1. The Upside-Down Inn - An inn build completely upside down. Of course, it's a gimmick, but it seems to have worked as the inn enjoys a constant clientele.
2. The Chapel - A place of worship that has gained popularity for its unusual architecture and stunning mountain views.
3. Gail's - An inn featuring a mummified lizard/human creature.
4. Doll's Head Trail - A forest trail system marked with giant creepy doll heads. There's a gift shop as well.
5. The Great Castle - A supposedly haunted and immensely ancient castle visitors can tour for a small fee.
6. The Walk Through Zoo - A zoo with a caged tunnel where guests walk through the animal habitats.
7. Spacer's Rest - An asteroid trading post with a gigantic statue of a frog out front. Known for buoy signs saying, "Come see the frog!"
8. Fun Over the World - An amusement park built on a small rocky moon. It features a few roller coasters and other carnival rides. However, most rides and buildings seem to be run down.
9. Hole In The Rock - An asteroid with a natural hole all the way through it. Some spacers have taken to flying through it as a way to bring good luck on a journey. Of course, a gift shop and tavern have popped up nearby.
10. Wild Blueberry Land - A farm where guests can pick berries and buy jellies and jams.
11. The Garden Maze - A huge curated maze cut into a beautiful garden. Visitors can explore the maze and enjoys several shops.
12. The Pie Factory - A restaurant known for its wide variety of pies and homely atmosphere.
13. Conspiracy Theory Museum - A museum dedicated to wild theories and ideas.
14. Largest Working Spinning Wheel - A marketing play by a small tavern. Some spacers say the spinning is not worth the stop but the food at the tavern is actually quite good.
15. The Lost Mermaid Cove - An inn with a large water tank featuring several merfolk performers. Oldtimers say the shows used to be better back in the day.
16. Souvenir World - A whole world dedicated to the production and sale of souvenirs.
17. The Mystery House - A huge, eerie house with bizarre scenes set up in each room. Visitors say the price of admission is getting too high.
18. The Grand Aquatarium - Maybe the attraction was grand a hundred years ago but no longer. The tanks are foggy for lack of care and the variety of creatures seems to have dwindled through attrition.
19. Kenley Carousel - A huge elaborate carousel with a number of shops and inns nearby.
20. The Owlbear Caverns - A beautiful cave system on a certain world where people can take tours. Several shops and restaurants are available for visitors.
21. Captain's - A huge infamous inn located near a spaceport known for an enormous statue of a space captain holding a turkey leg.

45. Randarr's Zoo - A rundown complex containing a random collection of animals in unsanitary cages. The heyday of the zoo is clearly in the past.
46. Alligator Farm & Petting Zoo - This attraction features alligator shows every hour as well as goats and ponies that can be petted.
47. The Gardens of Zinn - A gorgeous botanical garden complex offering tours, lectures, and demonstrations. An expensive gift shop and cafe are also available.
48. Mystery Vortex - An asteroid with an odd gravitational field. Come for the tours and stay for the restaurant.
