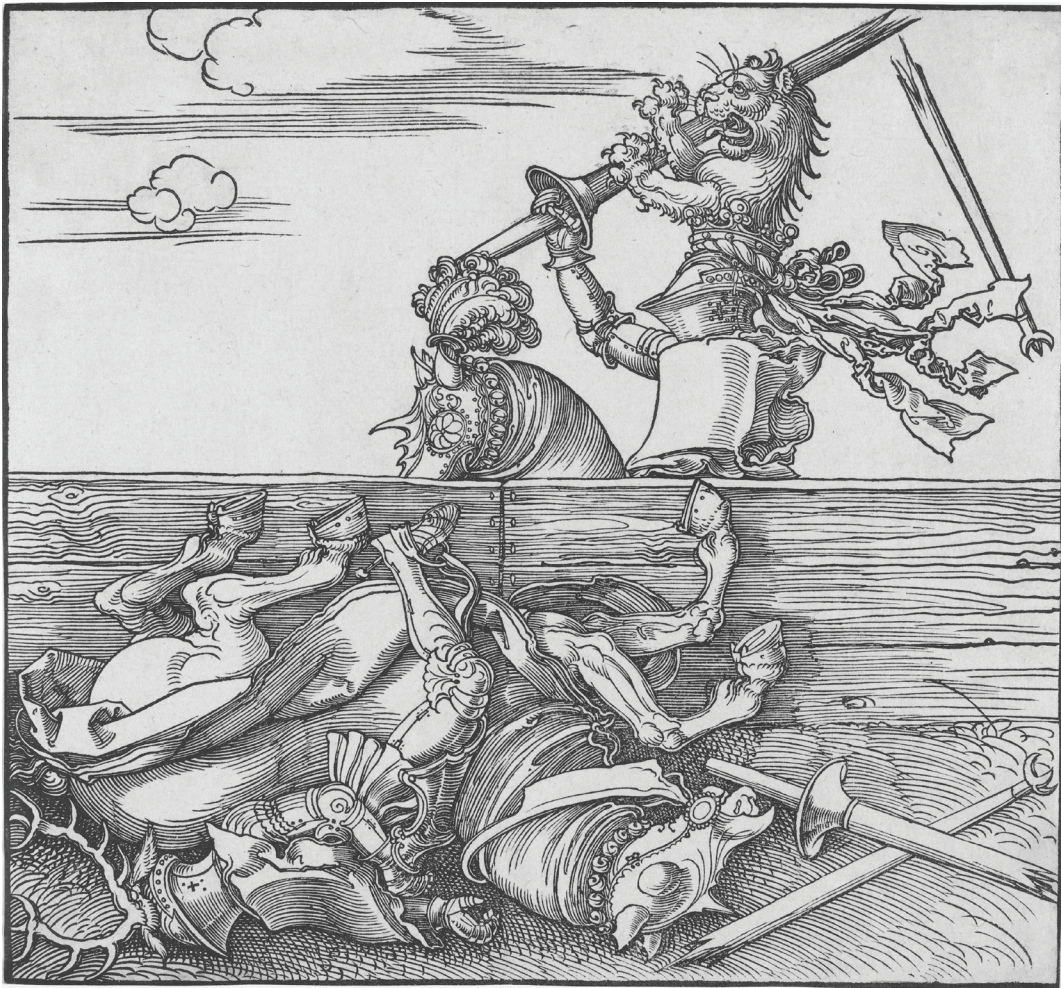

"Conspiracies & Encounters" is the section of tables meant to add conflict and entanglements to the sessions. Use these tables to give players something to sink their teeth into.

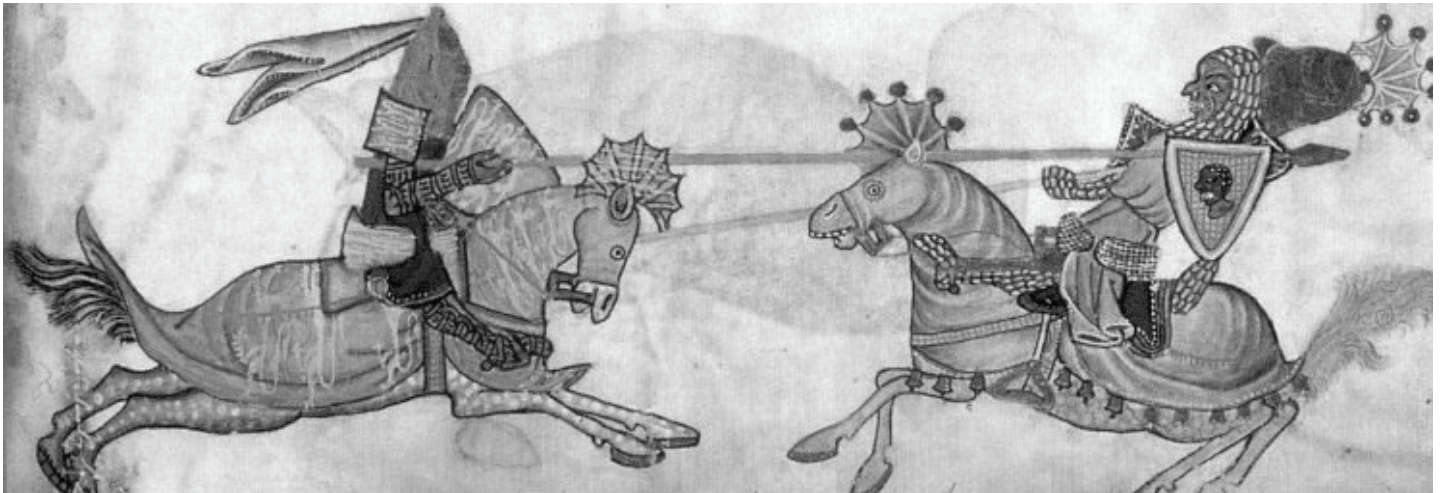
