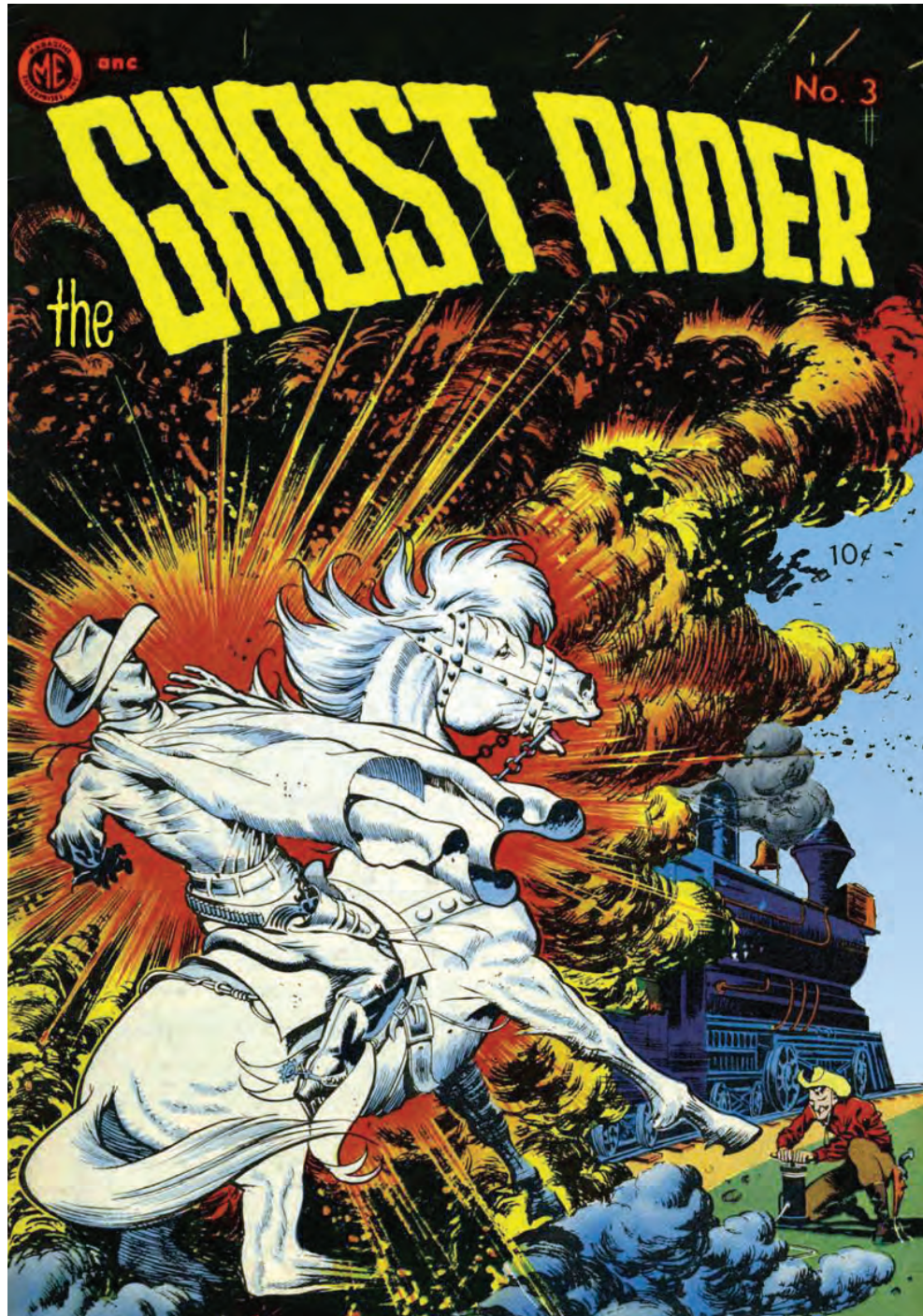

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

THE BOOK OF RANDOM TABLES: SUPERHEROES is designed to assist game masters by reducing preparation time and enhancing session details. It's intended for use with superhero tabletop role-playing games set in a modern environment.

Most of the tables are D100, with some being D10. Game masters can use these tables either before or during sessions, and they can even have players roll on them. There's magic in randomness—embrace it.

The book is organized into sections, summarized below:

First is a simple *Random Superhero Generator*. It's not exhaustive nor meant to create complete characters, but rather to allow GMs to quickly generate villains or super NPCs.

The next section is *Story Hooks*, which contains two D100 tables. One table provides fictional headlines that could hint at supervillain activity, while the other offers one hundred street encounters to kickstart sessions or introduce plot twists.

Items & Things contains ten D100 tables ranging from Items at a Crime Scene to Items in a Bank Vault, Items in a Semi-Trailer, Items in a Supervillain Lab, and more.

The *NPCs* section is extensive, with 1,200 different non-player characters, plus a table of personality traits. The NPC tables are divided into 400 Informants, 400 Law Enforcement Contacts, and 400 NPCs that can be used as sidekicks or crime victims.

Next is the *Names* section, containing 700 names across various tables, including Common American Surnames, Popular Modern American Female Names, Popular Modern American Male Names, Henchmen Names, Super Villain Names, and Superhero Names.

The final section, *Weaknesses*, has one table. All superheroes need their kryptonite, and this table offers GMs and players interesting or humorous options for superhero weaknesses.

Add these tables to your game master kit for extra detail that brings sessions to life. Your players will enjoy the fight for justice, and remember—the world always needs more heroes.

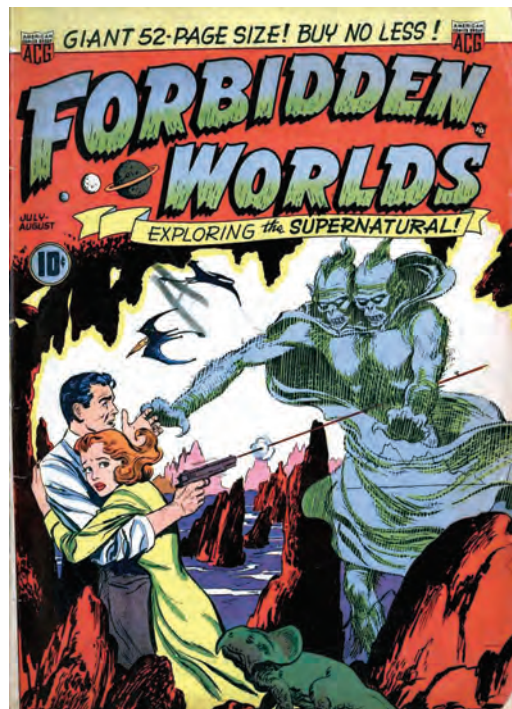

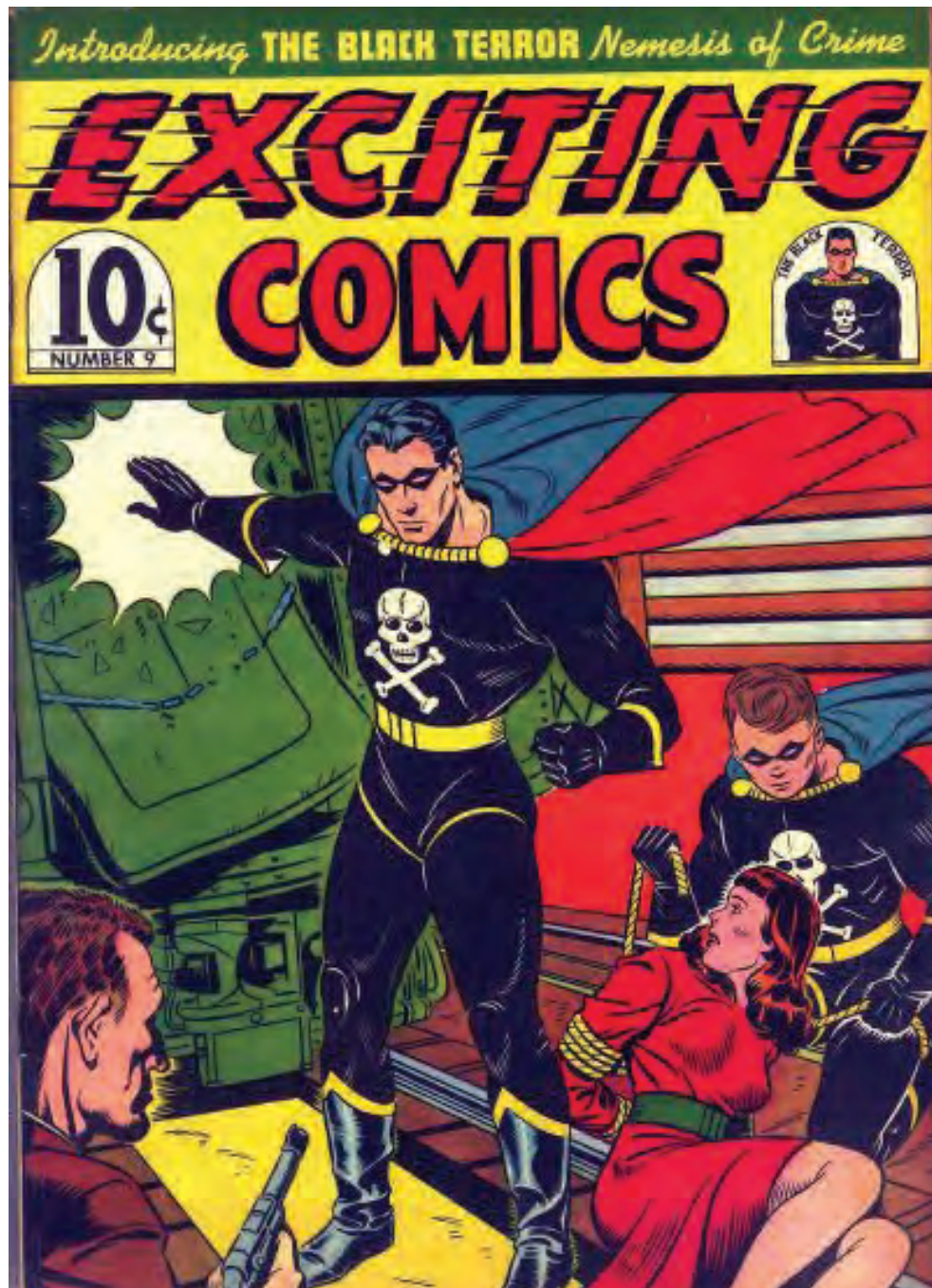
