





How to Use this Book

Whether you are playing Dungeons and Dragons or another tabletop role-playing game, this book helps game masters add a Viking flair to their campaigns. As with the other Books of Random Tables, this book helps cut down session prep time.

The book has D100, D20, and D10 tables, providing a myriad of possibilities for game masters and players alike. The DM can roll on the tables or have the players do so. Either way, the game master doesn't have to spend time before the session filling in details—the tables do that work.

The sections of the book are as follows:

The first is "Items & Things." Here you will find tables like Food and Drink, Items in a Jarl's Chamber, Items in a Longboat, Items in a Longhouse, Items in a Ship Burial Site, and more.

The "Names" section provides various names from clan names to ship names and more. All of these add a Viking and Norse feel to your gaming world.

In "Norse Mythology," you will discover 40 researched and detailed quests, plus even more fascinating objects and runes.



The "People" section includes two tables: Ship Captains and Shipwreck Survivors, giving dungeon masters interesting NPCs to engage their players.


"Rumors & Odd Jobs" is the last section. It contains one table, but it could be the basis for hours of fun in a session or even months of gaming action in a campaign.


Norse Mythology Quests #1

1. Loki has wagered his head, if the dwarves create a weapon that will return to its owner every time. The dwarves succeeded in making the weapon, and now Loki is trying to hide from his peers. Help him hide.
2. Skrymir has challenged your party to five seemingly easy (but actually impossible) tasks. First: Out-eat a guy named Logi. Second: Win a race against a guy named Hugi. Third: Drink a hornful of some kind of drink. Fourth: Pick up Skrymir's pet cat. Fifth: Wrestle with Skrymir's old nurse, Elli. However, nothing is what it seems: Logi-the-Eater is the embodiment of wildfire. Hugi-the-Swift is thought personified. The horn with the drink is connected to the ocean. The pet cat is actually the World Serpent, who surrounds the earth itself. Elli-the-nurse is the personification of old age. Your job is not to complete these impossible tasks but to impress Skrymir in your attempts.
3. You have been challenged to go pluck a beard hair from a giant. The party member or group who is able to do so will be handsomely rewarded for their daring, and they can keep the hair to use as a spear.
4. Jormungandr, the World Serpent, is writhing in pain, and the universe is coming apart at the seams because of his thrashing about. The party must identify what is wrong with him and find a way to stop his flailing.
5. Odin's Hunt has captured a local boy and is forcing him to join the throng. Find a way to rescue him by joining the hunt yourself. But beware, you must find a way to get yourselves out of the hunt as well.
6. Two kings have been cursed by the Valkyrie Hildr to battle with each other forever. If you defeat Hildr or convince her to stop resurrecting the kings and forcing them to fight, these two kings will help you with your quest.
7. The powerful necklace Brisingamen, worn by Freya the Goddess of War, has been stolen by Loki. Now Odin has it and demands that Freya spread eternal war in Midgard in exchange for it. Help her steal back her necklace to avoid everlasting war.
8. The party finds golden game pieces in the grass. They learn that the pieces once belonged to the gods of old. If the pieces are brought to Alfheim, the Realm of the Elves, they can be infused with magical powers.
9. One of the gods has been captured by a king and tied to a post between two raging fires. Though he does not truly need to be rescued, he waits for someone to save him, so that he can reward the rescuer. Get to him before his cloak catches on fire.
10. Two brothers, the sons of a king, went fishing and were blown away by a great wind. They were shipwrecked, and Odin and his wife, Frigg, fostered the boys for many years. Odin raised the younger son, and Frigg the older. Eventually, Odin and Frigg gave them a boat to sail back to their kingdom. However, Odin secretly told the younger boy to jump out of the boat as soon as it landed and push his brother back out to sea. The younger became an evil king of the land, and his brother was lost in the land of the giants. Find the older brother by fighting and outwitting the giants, and bring him back as the rightful heir to the throne.





11. A sorcerer-in-disguise has secretly come into the land and is wreaking havoc, but nobody knows who he is. The goddess has sent her servant to the land with this clue: "No dog is brave enough to bark, or even so much as look, at this sorcerer." Use the hint from the servant to find the sorcerer and stop him.
12. Odin is disguised as a ferryman on the other side of a great river. He is insulting your party and refusing to ferry you over. If you hurl insults back and impress him enough with your witty slander, he will deem you worthy of a ferry ride.
13. An ancient giant, Vafthrudnir, knows much of the past, present, and future. Test yourself against him in a battle of wits.
14. Sacrifice a body part to the Well of Mimir in order to gain knowledge for a larger quest.
15. A terrible giant has stolen all of your weapons and is demanding a beautiful bride in exchange for them. One of your party must fool him by dressing like a bride and keeping him entertained while the others look for the weapons.
16. A group of berserkers has descended upon an unprotected village. You must defend it, or it will be ravaged.
17. A sorcerer uses his wand to cause trouble in the land. Find a way to trick him into giving you his wand, and then use it to enchant away his wits, so he is no longer dangerous.
18. Lava giants are hurling molten stones into a heavily populated valley. Go stop them by subduing or destroying them.
19. Travel to the depths of hell to raise a prophetic witch from the dead and command her to tell you important information for the main quest.
20. Go fishing...for the Midgard Serpent. (A bull or steer's head is great bait.)





1. Fenrir has broken his bonds. Find a new rope and bind the beastly dog before he brings on Ragnarok prematurely.
2. There is a cursed cup that constantly refills itself with human blood and attracts bloodthirsty lava hawks to it. It must be destroyed, but the only thing hard enough to shatter it is a giant's head.
3. The party has been captured by a giant. Trick the giant by keeping it talking until sunrise, and it will be turned to stone.
4. Travel to an island filled with dangerous beasts. This island has forty-six swords hidden on it. One of these swords is greater than the rest. There is a blood-red dragon embossed on its blade, an ouroboros upon the handguard, and a ring on its hilt. It carries courage in its middle and terror in its point.
5. A Valkyrie lies sleeping in a tower surrounded by flaming shields. There is a cursed, magical thorn under her armor that keeps her from waking up. Only a very sharp object can cut through her armor so that the thorn can be pulled away. But be careful not to cut her. The armor is on so tightly that it appears to be a part of her skin. If you wake her, she will give you one of two rewards: She will ride with you into battle or give you special wisdom.
6. Kill a dragon when he slips away from his hoard. If you taste some of his blood, you will be given the ability to understand the speech of birds.
7. Sacrifice a part of your body (eye, leg, finger) to get a special rune of power.
8. An epic blade has been cursed by a witch. The curse pronounces that the blade will do three evils, in addition to killing someone every time it is drawn. Break the curse on it by drawing it upon the witch herself. It is a powerful blade and very tempting to use before the curse is broken. Therefore, one must be prepared for any consequences each time it is drawn.
9. King Frothi has chained the beautiful giantesses, Fenja and Menja, to a magical grindstone that grinds out gold, peace, and whatever else he wishes. However, Fenja and Menja secretly plan to magically grind out an army that will destroy the land. You must free them and convince them not to take out their wrath upon the entire land. Then, go help them take vengeance upon King Frothi for their imprisonment.
10. Find a magical rune in each of the nine realms and combine them to create a power to fight your enemy.





11. Learn from a Rune Master how to carve important runes into your weapons in order to give you more victories.
12. A young maiden who comes from a powerful family has recently fallen ill. No one knows that a foolish and lovesick young man has carved rudimentary runes into a whalebone and hidden it under her mattress, in an attempt to cause her to fall in love with him. This is what is causing her illness. Discover the cause, scratch out the runes, and burn the whalebone. Help the man to find a better way to woo her if he seems worthy of her love.
13. A neighboring evil king has set up a nithing pole to curse the land of his enemy. Now the land will not produce healthy crops, and thieves will roam the realm. Sneak or fight your way into the land of the evil king and destroy the nithing pole.
14. A guardian spirit has been cursed by a nithing pole and cannot regain his power to protect an important family. The family has asked you to find the nithing pole, destroy it, and then help the guardian spirit regain his power by bringing a sacrifice to the gods at Asgard.
15. The priestess of a local village has cast sticks of wood carved with prophetic runes into a bowl of goat's blood. She has discovered through this divination that a warlike neighboring village plans to loot and destroy this peace-loving village. Ask the priestess to divine more details, and create a plan to defend the community.
16. Frost Giant Thiazi has gotten Loki to lure the lovely Ydun out of Asgard with the promise of beautiful apples. She is kidnapped by the frost giant and locked away in his home. Without her presence, the gods begin to age. Help get Ydun out of the hands of Thiazi and back to Asgard.
17. Freya and Odin are arguing over who gets which dead warriors to come to their respective halls. Find a way to get the two to come to an agreement.
18. Three brothers have stolen three valkyries' swan cloaks and are trying to force the valkyries to marry them. Help the valkyries fight the brothers and find their swan cloaks.
19. Huginn, one of the two ravens that fly around the world and gather information for Odin, has gone missing. Odin always feared this would happen. The other raven, Muninn, seems to know something about his disappearance but is unwilling to tell Odin or the party. Find a way to get Muninn to divulge his information, and go find Huginn.
20. A friend (or party member) has died and has descended to Hel. In order to retrieve the person from Hel, the party must find a way to borrow or steal Sleipnir, Odin's eight-legged horse, use the horse to lead them to Hel, and finish whatever task Hel has chosen in order to earn the friend's release.




